## Weather Summary

Temperatures throughout the state were above average for the week. Las Vegas had the highest temperature at 107 degrees, and Eureka had the lowest temperature at 32. Precipitation ranged from none in Las Vegas and Reno to 0.06 inches in Tonopah.

## **Crops Summary**

Days Suitable for Fieldwork: 7 days. Topsoil Moisture: 10% Very Short, 15% Short, 65% Adequate, and 10% Surplus. Subsoil Moisture: 10% Very Short, 10% Short, 65% Adequate, and 15% Surplus. Pasture and Range Condition: 5% Very Poor, 5% Poor, 30% Fair, 55% Good, and 5% Excellent.
