Weather Summary

Temperatures throughout the state were mostly below average for the week. Las Vegas had the highest temperature at 106 degrees, and Ely had the lowest temperature at 27. The state saw little precipitation throughout the week, with .01 inches in Eureka being the most.

Crops Summary

Days Suitable for Fieldwork: 7 days. Topsoil Moisture: 15% Very Short, 20% Short, and 65% Adequate. Subsoil Moisture: 10% Very Short, 20% Short, and 70% Adequate. Pasture and Range Condition: 10% Very Poor, 10% Poor, 40% Fair, and 40% Good.
