Weather Summary

Temperatures throughout the state were slightly below average for the week. Las Vegas had the highest temperature at 113 degrees, and Eureka had the lowest temperature at 39 degrees. Precipitation measured .28 inches in Eureka and .25 in Winnemucca. Ely and Tonopah reported .09 inches of precipitation. Las Vegas had trace precipitation.

Crops Summary

Days Suitable for Fieldwork: 7 days. Topsoil Moisture: 15 Very Short, 20% Short, 65% Adequate. Subsoil Moisture: 10% Very Short, 20% Short, and 70% Adequate. Pasture and Range Condition: 10% Very Poor, 10% Poor, 40% Fair, and 40% Good.
