Weather Summary

Temperatures throughout the state were below average for the week. Las Vegas had the highest temperature at 102 degrees, and Ely had the lowest temperature at 29 degrees. Precipitation was 0.03 inches in Ely. Reno, Elko, Winnemucca and Tonopah received trace precipitation.

Crops Summary

Days Suitable for Fieldwork: 7 days. Topsoil Moisture: 5% Very Short, 60% Short, 35% Adequate. Subsoil Moisture: 5% Very Short, 55% Short, and 40% Adequate. Pasture and Range Condition: 5% Very Poor, 10% Poor, 25% Fair, and 60% Good.
