Weather Summary

Temperatures throughout the state were below average for the week. Las Vegas had the highest temperature at 95 degrees, and Ely had the lowest temperature at 26 degrees. Precipitation was 1.16 inches in Elko, .26 in Winnemucca and .04 in Eureka. Reno and Ely reported .02 inches of precipitation.

Crops Summary

Days Suitable for Fieldwork: 7 days. Topsoil Moisture: 5% Very Short, 60% Short, 35% Adequate. Subsoil Moisture: 60% Short, and 40% Adequate. Pasture and Range Condition: 5% Very Poor, 10% Poor, 20% Fair, and 65% Good.
