Weather Summary Weather Report for Nevada for the week ending on Sunday, September 29, 2019:

The average lows for Nevada ranged from 26 in Winnemucca to 61 degrees in Las Vegas. The average highs ranged from 78 in Winnemucca to 94 degrees in Las Vegas. Precipitation for Nevada ranged from 0.05 inches in Eureka, 0.14 inches in Winnemucca, 0.15 inches in Tonopah, 0.22 inches in Reno, 0.24 inches in Las Vegas, 0.69 inches in Ely, and 0.88 inches in Elko.

Crops Summary

Days Suitable for Fieldwork: 4.2 days. Topsoil Moisture: 10% Very Short, 50% Short, 40% Adequate. Subsoil Moisture: 5% Very Short 45% Short, and 50% Adequate. Pasture and Range Condition: 10% Very Poor, 10% Poor, 20% Fair, and 60% Good.
