Weather Summary

Weather Report for Nevada for the week ending on Sunday, May 17, 2020:

The average lows for Nevada ranged from 32 degrees in Ely and Eureka to 62 degrees in Las Vegas. The average highs ranged from 78 degrees in Reno and Ely to 96 degrees in Las Vegas. Precipitation for Nevada ranged from 0.01 inches in Reno and Winnemucca, and 0.02 inches in Elko.

Days Suitable for Fieldwork: 6.5 days. Topsoil Moisture: 10% Very Short, 20% Short, and 70% Adequate. Subsoil Moisture: 10% Very Short, 20% Short, and 70% Adequate.
