Weather Summary

Weather Report for Nevada for the week ending on Sunday, May 24, 2020:

The average lows for Nevada ranged from 23 degrees in Ely to 61 degrees in Las Vegas. The average highs ranged from 71 degrees in Eureka to 91 degrees in Las Vegas. Precipitation for Nevada ranged from 0.04 inches in Reno, 0.15 inches in Ely, 0.34 inches in Eureka and Tonopah, 0.66 inches in Elko, and 1.09 inches in Winnemucca.

Crops Summary

Days Suitable for Fieldwork: 7.0 days. Topsoil Moisture: 5% Very Short, 20% Short, and 75% Adequate. Subsoil Moisture: 10% Very Short, 20% Short, and 70% Adequate.
