Weather Summary

The average lows for Nevada ranged from 40 degrees in Ely to 78 degrees in Las Vegas. The average highs ranged from 91 degrees in Eureka to 108 degrees in Las Vegas. Precipitation for Nevada ranged from 0.01 inches in Tonopah, 0.05 inches in Winnemucca, and 0.24 inches in Reno.

Crops Summary

Days Suitable for Fieldwork: 7.0 days. Topsoil Moisture: 15% very short, 25% short, and 60% adequate. Subsoil Moisture: 15% very short, 25% short and 60% adequate. Pasture and Range Condition: 10% Poor, 20% Fair, 35% Good, and 35% Excellent.
