Weather Summary

The average lows for Nevada ranged from 42 degrees in Ely to 78 degrees in Las Vegas. The average highs ranged from 95 degrees in Ely to 114 degrees in Las Vegas. Precipitation for Nevada ranged from 0.02 inches in Reno, and 0.08 inches in Winnemucca.

Crops Summary

Days Suitable for Fieldwork: 7.0 days. Topsoil Moisture: 20% very short, 30% short and 50% adequate. Subsoil Moisture: 20% very short, 30% short and 50% adequate. Pasture and Range Condition: 10% Poor, 20% Fair, 35% Good, and 35% Excellent.
