Weather Summary

The average lows for Nevada ranged from 40 degrees in Eureka to 80 degrees in Las Vegas. The average highs ranged from 97 degrees in Ely to 113 degrees in Las Vegas. Precipitation for Nevada ranged from 0.04 inches in Tonopah, and 0.09 inches in Ely.

Crops Summary

Days Suitable for Fieldwork: 7.0 days. Topsoil Moisture: 20% very short, 25% short and 55% adequate. Subsoil Moisture: 15% very short, 30% short and 55% adequate. Pasture and Range Condition: 10% Poor, 20% Fair, 35% Good, and 35% Excellent.
