Weather Summary

The average lows for Nevada ranged from 43 degrees in Ely to 78 degrees in Las Vegas. The average highs ranged from 89 degrees in Eureka to 110 degrees in Las Vegas. Precipitation for Nevada ranged from 0.03 inches in Eureka, 0.08 inches in Elko, 0.09 inches in Reno, and 0.33 inches in Winnemucca.

Crops Summary

Days Suitable for Fieldwork: 7.0 days. Topsoil Moisture: 20% very short, 35% short and 45% adequate. Subsoil Moisture: 20% very short, 30% short and 50% adequate. Pasture and Range Condition: 10% Poor, 20% Fair, 40% Good, and 30% Excellent.
