Weather Summary

The average lows for Nevada ranged from 34 degrees in Ely to 75 degrees in Las Vegas. The average highs ranged from 95 degrees in Ely to 115 degrees in Las Vegas. No precipitation was observed at any of the reporting stations in Nevada.

Days Suitable for Fieldwork: 6.7 days. Topsoil Moisture: 25% very short, 30% short and 45% adequate. Subsoil Moisture: 20% very short, 30% short and 50% adequate. Pasture and Range Condition: 10% Very Poor, 20% Poor, 40% Fair, 30% Good.
