#### **Weather Summary**

The average lows for Nevada ranged from 22 degrees in Winnemucca to 53 degrees in Las Vegas. The average highs ranged from 83 degrees in Ely to 98 degrees in Las Vegas. Precipitation for Nevada ranged from 0.01 inches in Tonopah, 0.07 inches in Eureka, 0.14 inches in Elko, 0.32 inches in Winnemucca, and 0.49 inches in Ely.

## **Crops Summary**

Days Suitable for Fieldwork: 7.0 days. Topsoil Moisture: 5% very short, 10% short, and 85% adequate. Subsoil Moisture: 5% very short, 20% short, and 75% adequate. Pasture and Range Condition: 10% Very Poor, 10% Poor, 75% Fair, and 5% Good.
