This will be the last publication for the 2015 crop year. We hope everyone has a wonderful holiday season and good luck next spring!

<u>Good week for field work:</u> New England averaged 5.0 days suitable for field work last week.

Predominantly warmer weather characterized much of the New England region over the week of Thanksgiving with only a few spotty snow showers. Average weekly temperatures ranged from one degree below normal to eight degrees above normal. Weekly precipitation ranged from 0.00 to 1.97 inches. Now that crops have been harvested, farmers were able make progress on soil testing, cleaning fields and greenhouses, and spreading lime and manure. Barns and buildings were also readied for the winter. In Massachusetts, cranberry growers were maintaining ditches and winterizing equipment prior to applying the winter flood once temperatures drop. Orchardists spread vole bait and continued painting tree trunks. At the markets, a plethora of harvest bounty was available including carrots, sweet potatoes, onions, salad greens, Brussel sprouts, cabbage, winter squash, and turnips. Pies and breads were available too during the week alongside fresh apple cider.

PISCATAQUIS/SOMERSET, Elaine S. Moceus

Despite the first snowfall of the season during the beginning of this reporting week, receiving between covering the ground to 2 inches, the week has been unseasonably mild. Cool mornings in the low teens saw ice forming on some small ponds. Most areas saw a warm up to 50 degree temperatures during the latter part of the week.

MASSACHUSETTS

PLYMOUTH, Carolyn DeMoranville

With cranberry harvest finished, growers are maintaining ditches, winterizing pumps, and getting ready to apply the winter flood once temperatures drop.

NEW HAMPSHIRE

A few farms were still applying (injecting) manure over the last month.

HILLSBOROUGH, George Hamilton

Thanksgiving sales at farm stands were steady to very good. Farmers are now processing meats for Thanksgiving. Vegetables: Growers are moving in their winter storage crops. With warm temperatures, fall greens production has been good. Farmers are soil testing fields for next season, cleaning-out insides of greenhouses and high tunnels, picking up and cleaning fields, putting away farm equipment. Field Crops: Farmers are spreading manure and lime on fields, soil testing fields for next season, and cleaning and putting away farm equipment. Also, winterizing barns and buildings. Fruit: Orchardists busy marketing crop. Orchardists spreading bait to control voles and painting tree trunks. Also, repairing broken bins and cleaning and putting away farm equipment.

ROCKINGHAM, Nada Haddad

More root crops brought in from the fields put into winter storage. Winter CSA shares as well as winter farmers' markets had the following crops available: potatoes, carrots, parsnips, sweet potatoes, onions, leeks, watermelon, radishes, salad greens, cabbage, Brussel sprout stalks, winter squash, cilantro, turnips and apples. Pressing apples for cider. Pies and breads along with apples were available at farm stands. Cleaning fields. Spreading manure. Thanksgiving saw some relatively warm weather as opposed to last years' feet of snow. End of this week saw some very cold temperatures as well as rain. Some fields might be slightly frozen.

RHODE ISLAND

ALL RI COUNTIES, Alison Rose

This week the farmers continued to work on their equipment in preparation for storage during the winter months. Much of the fields have been seeded down with winter rye. This week has been a perfect week weather-wise. Temperatures in the 50s during the day and 30s at night.

Any annual crops for picking have been harvested in Franklin County. Nice fall weather has our water supplies in good shape for the winter months which are quickly approaching. Fall manure applications are pretty much taken care of except for some storage clean out close to the 12/15 winter spreading ban.

There is no field work to report this week. The past week was mild with the exception of some cold nights. There was no significant rainfall during the week as well. There were a few snow flurries over the weekend but the ground is still bare.
