According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New England, there were 5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, June 11, 2023. Topsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 25 percent short, 63 percent adequate, and 11 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 17 percent short, 61 percent adequate, and 22 percent surplus.
