January crop production report

Hay stocks are 71.9 million tons

CONCORD, NH – The USDA-NASS, Northeastern Region has released the monthly crop production, according to Angie Considine, acting state statistician of the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS), New England Field Office.

Hay stocks on farms: All hay stored on United States farms as of December 1, 2022 totaled 71.9 million tons, down 9% from December 1, 2021, which is the lowest December 1 stocks since 1954. Disappearance from May 1, 2022 - December 1, 2022, totaled 57.7 million tons, down 3% from the same period in 2021.

Record low December 1 hay stock levels were estimated in California, Colorado, and Nebraska.
