Milk production in **New York** during February 2024 totaled 1.26 billion pounds, up 2.5 percent from February 2023. The average milk price received by New York farmers in January 2024, at \$21.60 per hundredweight, is \$0.30 lower than December 2023 and \$2.10 lower than January a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during February 2024 totaled 795 million pounds, up 1.8 percent from February 2023. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in January 2024, at \$21.30 per hundredweight, is \$0.50 lower than December 2023 and \$2.60 lower than January a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during February 2024 totaled 200 million pounds, up 2.0 percent from February 2023. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in January 2024, at \$22.00 per hundredweight, is \$0.40 lower than December 2023 and \$2.10 lower than January a year ago.
