Range and pasture conditions are 1% very poor, 11% poor, 31% fair, 49% good, 8% excellent. Hay conditions are 4% poor, 44% fair, 45% good, and 7% excellent. Corn conditions are 6% poor, 23% fair, 48% good, and 23% excellent. Soybeans conditions are 4% poor, 21% fair, 54% good, and 21% excellent. Silage corn is 97 harvested, 98% in 2012 and 97% average. Corn for grain is 40% harvested, 54% in 2012 and 38% five year average. Winter Wheat is 82% emerged. Potatoes are 97% harvested, 100% in 2012 and 94% average. Soybeans are 65% harvested, 80% in 2012 and 63% average. Apples are 7% poor, 7% fair, 37% good, and 49% excellent. Grapes are 5% poor, 11% fair, 40% good, 44% excellent. Apples are 93% harvested, 99% in 2012 and 92% average. Pears are 100% harvested, 100% in 2012 and 100% average. Grapes are 94% harvested, 99% 2012 and 96% average. Rainfall for the state ranged from 0.03 to 2.00 inches. Temperatures ranged from a low of 18 to a high of 71.
