According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New York, there were 6.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday; June 27, 2021. Topsoil moisture supplies were 15 percent very short, 47 percent short, 36 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 14 percent very short, 38 percent short, 47 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus.
