According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New York, there were 6 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, August 14, 2022. Topsoil moisture supplies were 30 percent very short, 34 percent short, 34 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 26 percent very short, 29 percent short, 45 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus.
