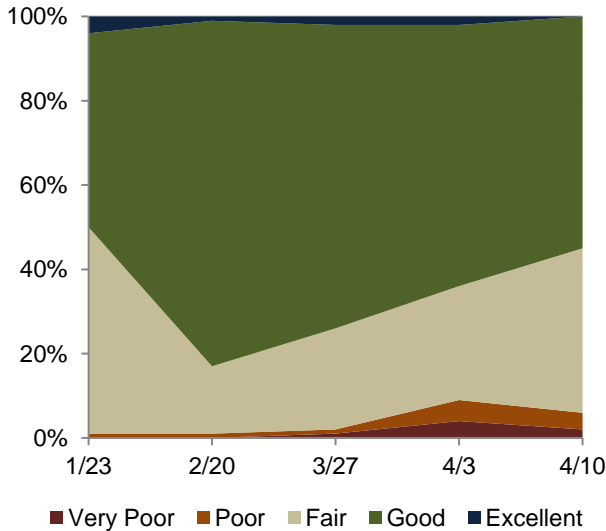

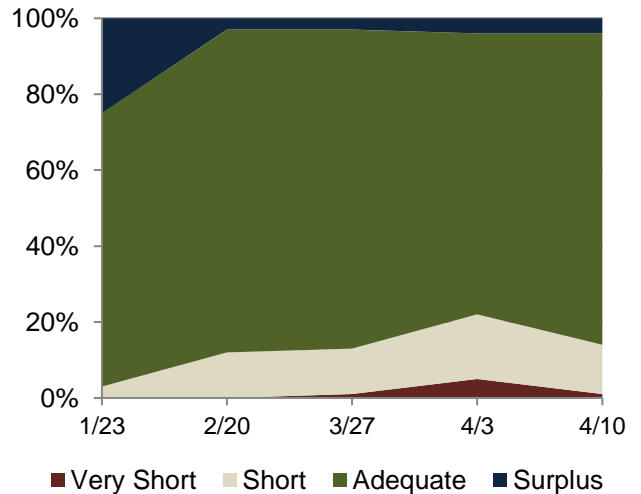

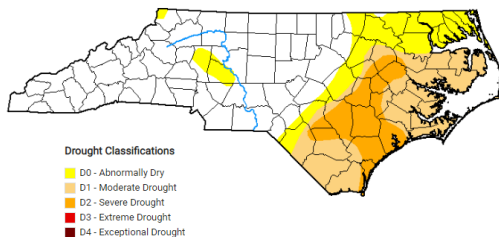
OATS CONDITION



TOPSOIL MOISTURE PERCENT

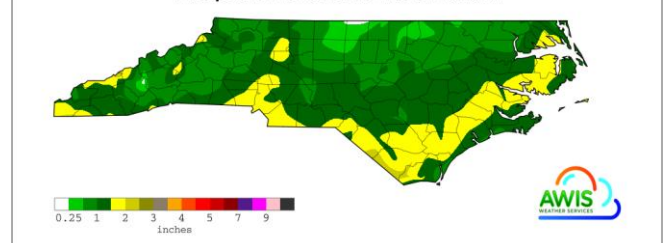


Map depicts current drought conditions as of April 5, 2022.
