



UPLAND COTTON YIELD (Pounds)






Cotton production on December 1, 2023 is estimated at 735,000 480-pound bales, DOWN 27% from 2022.




COTTON GINNINGS - RUNNING BALES GINNED (Year to Date)



MONTHLY PRICE RECEIVED FOR SOYBEANS



MONTHLY PRICE RECEIVED FOR WINTER WHEAT



(Dollars per Bushel)




