JUNE 2023 HOG REPORT

All hogs and pigs on **North Carolina** farms on June 1, 2023, totaled 7.6 million head, down 5% from last quarter and down 7% from last year. Market hogs, at 6.8 million head, were down 8% from last year. Breeding stock totaled 800,000 head, up 1% from last quarter and down 2% from last year. The State's pig crop during the March–May 2023 period totaled 4.4 million head, up 1% from the same period last year. These pigs were produced by 400,000 sows. Pigs saved per litter averaged 11.00, which is up from the 10.40 pigs saved during the same quarter last year. North Carolina producers intend to farrow 405,000 sows during the June–August 2023 quarter and 405,000 sows during the September–November 2023 quarter. North Carolina currently ranks 3rd nationally, behind lowa and Minnesota, in the total number of hogs and pigs produced.
