## **DECEMBER 2023 HOG REPORT**

All hogs and pigs on **North Carolina** farms on December 1, totaled 7.8 million head, down 4% from September 1. Market hogs, at 7.02 million head, are down 6% from last year and down 4% from last quarter. Breeding stock totaled 780,000 head, down 3% from last year and down 3% from September 1, 2023. The State's pig crop during the September - November 2023 period totaled 4.736 million head, up 1% from the same period last year. These pigs were produced by 410,000 sows, a 2% decrease from 2022. Pigs saved per litter averaged at 11.55, compared to 11.15 the same quarter last year. North Carolina producers intend to farrow 395,000 sows during the December 2023 - February 2024 quarter and 400,000 sows during the March - May 2024 quarter. North Carolina currently ranks 3rd nationally, behind lowa and Minnesota, in the total number of hogs and pigs produced.
