## NORTH DAKOTA CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

**FARGO, N.D. November 25, 2019** - For the week ending November 24, 2019, there were 4.0 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 0 percent very short, 0 short, 49 adequate, and 51 surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 0 percent very short, 0 short, 54 adequate, and 46 surplus.

**Field Crops Report:** Soybeans harvested was 89 percent, behind 94 last year and 99 for the five-year average.

Winter wheat condition rated 4 percent very poor, 5 poor, 26 fair, 57 good, and 8 excellent.

Corn condition rated 3 percent very poor, 11 poor, 36 fair, 46 good, and 4 excellent. Corn harvested was 30 percent, well behind 79 last year and 91 average.

Sunflower condition rated 6 percent very poor, 14 poor, 35 fair, 42 good, and 3 excellent. Sunflowers harvested was 41 percent, well behind 79 last year and 90 average.

Potatoes harvested was 95 percent.

Dry edible beans harvested was 95 percent.

**Pasture and Range Report:** Pasture and range conditions rated 2 percent very poor, 10 poor, 27 fair, 52 good, and 9 excellent.

Stock water supplies rated 0 percent very short, 3 short, 71 adequate, and 26 surplus.
