NORTH DAKOTA CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

FARGO, N.D. October 26, 2020 - For the week ending October 25, 2020, there were 3.7 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 24% very short, 40% short, 34% adequate, and 2% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 22% very short, 37% short, 38% adequate, and 3% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Soybeans harvested was 97%, well ahead of 26% last year and 76% for the five-year average.

Winter wheat condition rated 1% very poor, 8% poor, 40% fair, 48% good, and 3% excellent. Winter wheat emerged was 91%, ahead of 78% last year and 83% average.

Corn harvested was 73%, well ahead of 5% last year and 33% average.

Sunflower condition rated 1% very poor, 10% poor, 32% fair, 51% good, and 6% excellent. Sunflowers harvested was 58%, well ahead of 10% last year and 37% average.

Pasture and Range Report: Pasture and range conditions rated 15% very poor, 34% poor, 34% fair, 15% good, and 2% excellent.

Stock water supplies rated 11% very short, 33% short, 56% adequate, and 0% surplus.
