NORTH DAKOTA CROP PROGRESS AND CONDITION

FARGO, N.D. November 21, 2022 - For the week ending November 20, 2022, there were 2.3 days suitable for fieldwork, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Topsoil moisture supplies rated 22% very short, 41% short, 37% adequate, and 0% surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies rated 25% very short, 44% short, 31% adequate, and 0% surplus.

Field Crops Report: Winter wheat condition rated 2% very poor, 4% poor, 31% fair, 62% good, and 1% excellent.

Sunflowers harvested was 94%, ahead of 89% last year and 77% average.

Pasture and Range Report: Pasture and range conditions rated 4% very poor, 26% poor, 41% fair, 28% good, and 1% excellent.

Stock water supplies rated 9% very short, 37% short, 54% adequate, and 0% surplus.
