

# 2001 OREGON VINEYARD AND WINERY REPORT

February, 2002

Frequency: Annual

The number of vineyards and wineries continued to grow in 2001. There were a record 8,800 vineyard acres harvested with 22,800 tons of wine grapes produced. All wine grape price rose to \$1,480 per ton. There were 131 wineries that crushed 22,163 tons of wine grapes. Cooperage capacity increased in 2001 to 5,542,000 gallons. Wineries reported unfilled grape needs of 19.2 tons, down 92 percent from 2000. Funding for this survey was provided by the Oregon Wine Advisory Board.

### Non-Grape Wine Summary

Wineries produced 35,690 gallons of non-grape wine, 1,870 more gallons than 2000 (not including hard apple cider). Blackberries were the leading fruit used to produce wine followed by: raspberries, peaches, cranberries, loganberries, rhubarb, plums, currants, pears, and cherries. Less than 1,000 gallons of boysenberry and honey wine were produced. This summary includes estimates for incomplete responses.
