# Crop Progress & Condition

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Week ending June 19, 2022

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According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Pennsylvania, there were 6.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, June 19, 2022. Topsoil moisture supplies were 23 percent short, 76 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 8 percent short, 90 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus.
