According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Pennsylvania, there were 4.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, April 30, 2023. Topsoil moisture supplies were 5 percent short, 86 percent adequate, and 9 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 13 percent short, 84 percent adequate, and 3 percent surplus.
