This report contains information on prices and values of production for major field crops and many specialty crops. All prices in this report are marketing year average prices, which are based on sales in the months comprising each commodity's marketing year. State-level value of production is computed by multiplying each state's price by its production.

US Value of Production for Field and Miscellaneous Crops up 3 Percent in 2022

The United States value of production for field and miscellaneous crops was estimated at \$219 billion in 2022, up 3 percent from 2021. Alabama's value of field and miscellaneous crop production totaled \$1.31 billion, up 2 percent from the previous year. At \$346 million, Alabama's leading value of production was cotton. The value of Florida's crop production totaled \$1.32 billion, an 8 percent increase from 2021. The value of Georgia's crop production was estimated at \$3.00 billion, an increase of 9 percent from the previous year. The leading crop production value for Georgia was cotton at \$1.25 billion. Field and miscellaneous crop values in South Carolina totaled \$998 million, a 5 percent increase from 2021. The value of corn for grain, at \$269 million, represented the largest value for South Carolina.
