Cotton production in the United States is forecast at 18.3 million bales for 2021, up slightly from the previous forecast and up 25 percent from last year. Sugarcane for sugar and seed is forecast at 33.5 million tons, down 7 percent from the previous year.

Key findings for the Southern Region from the December Crop Production report

Alabama: Cotton production is forecast at 755,000 bales, unchanged from the previous forecast but up 3 percent from 2020.

Florida: Cotton production is forecast at 130,000 bales, unchanged from the previous forecast but up 26 percent from last year. Sugarcane production for sugar and seed is forecast at 17.3 million tons, down 8 percent from 2020.

Georgia: Cotton production is forecast at 2.30 million bales, unchanged from the previous forecast but up 6 percent from 2020.

South Carolina: With yield forecast at a record high 960 pounds per acre, cotton production is forecast at 410,000 bales, up 4 percent from the previous forecast and up 37 percent from 2020.
