#### **Agricultural Land Value and Cash Rent Highlights**

The United States farm real estate value, a measurement of the value of all land and buildings on farms, averaged \$4,080 per acre for 2023, up \$280 per acre from 2022. Alabama farm real estate values increased \$100 per acre and Florida values increased \$300 per acre. Farm real estate values in Georgia increased \$390 per acre and in South Carolina values increased \$200 per acre.

Cash rent paid to landlords for all cropland in the United States increased \$7.00 to \$155.00 per acre in 2023. Cash rent for pasture increased to \$15.00 per acre up \$1.00 from last year. In Alabama, cash rent for cropland averaged \$70.00 per acre, an increase of \$1.00 from last year. Cash rent for cropland in Florida increased by \$11.00 to \$132.00 per acre. Georgia cash rent for cropland was up \$14.00 for 2023 at \$149.00 per acre. In South Carolina, cash rent for cropland increased \$0.50 to \$56.00 per acre.
