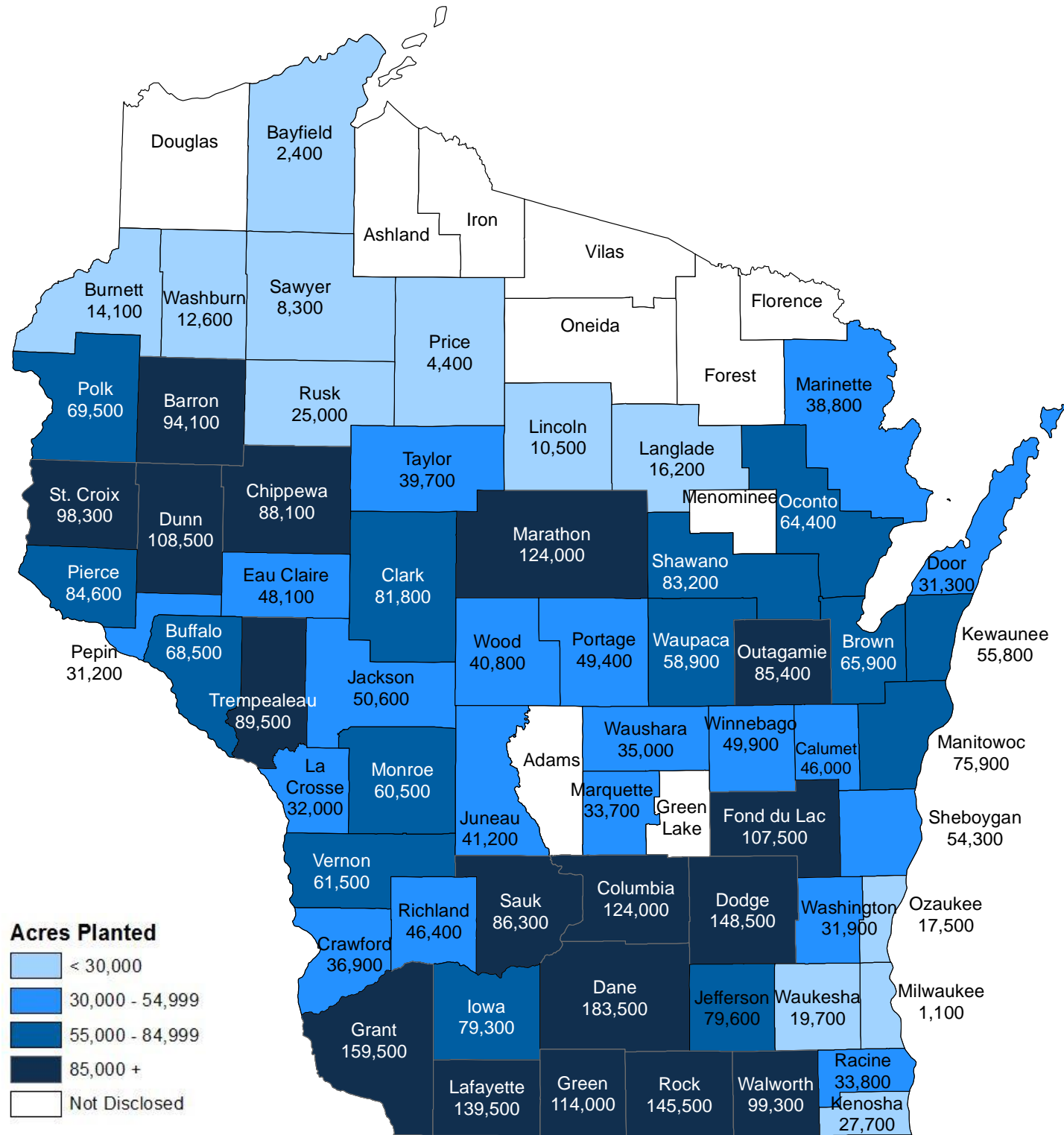

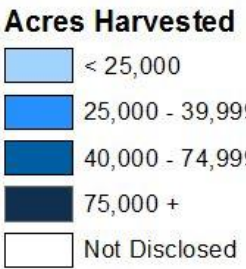
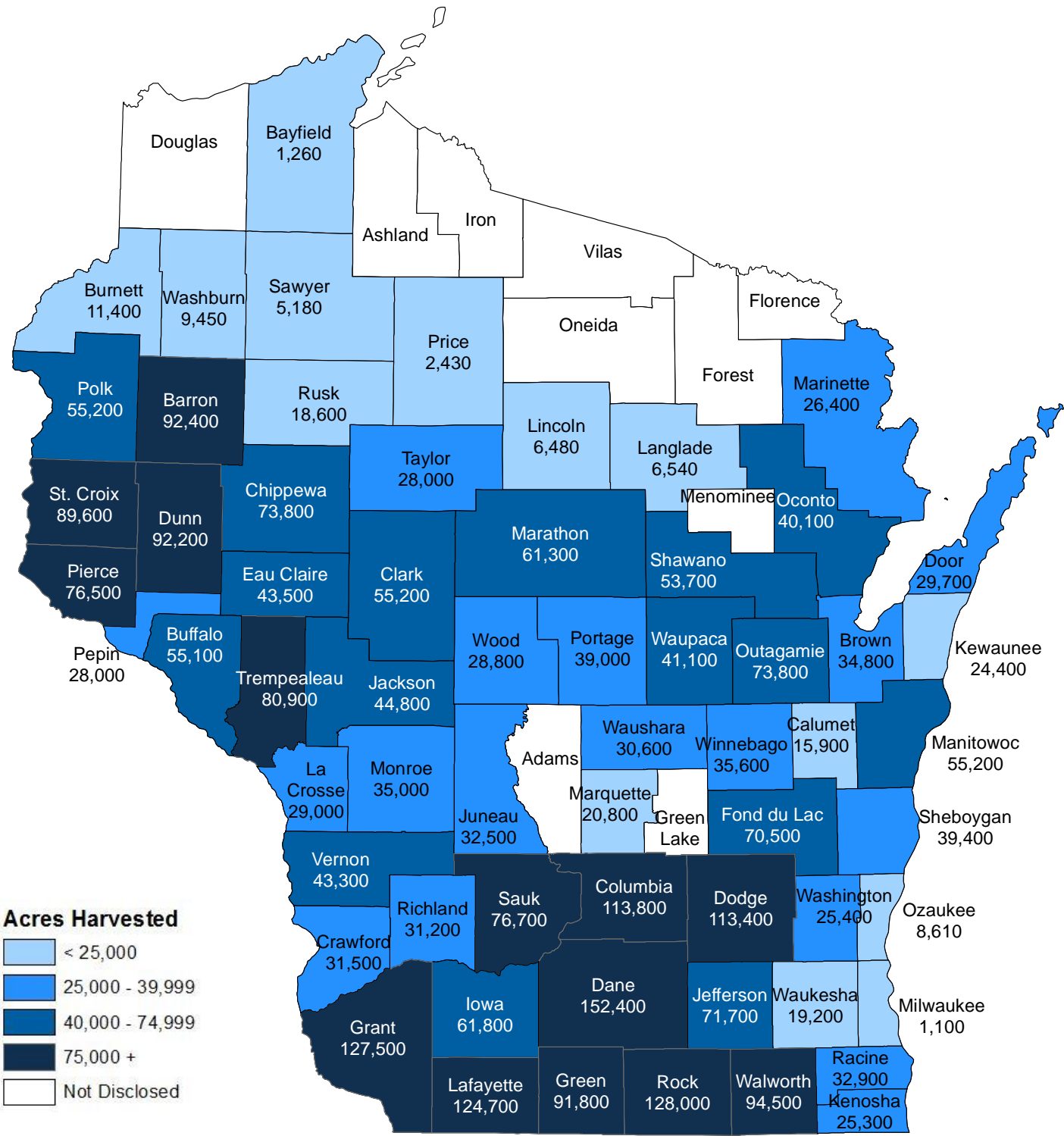

State Total: 3,140,000 Acres



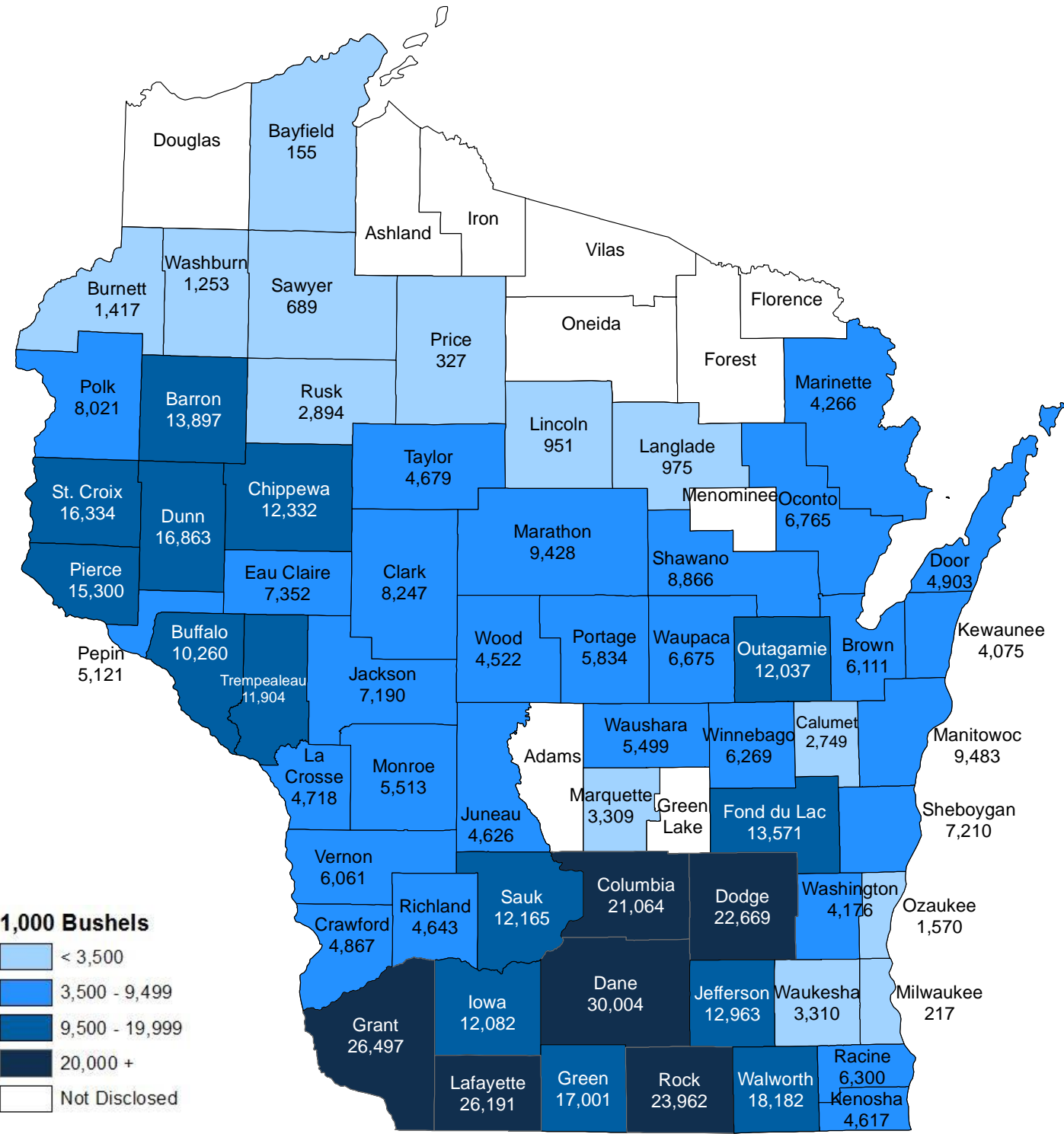

State Total: 552,640,000 Bushels



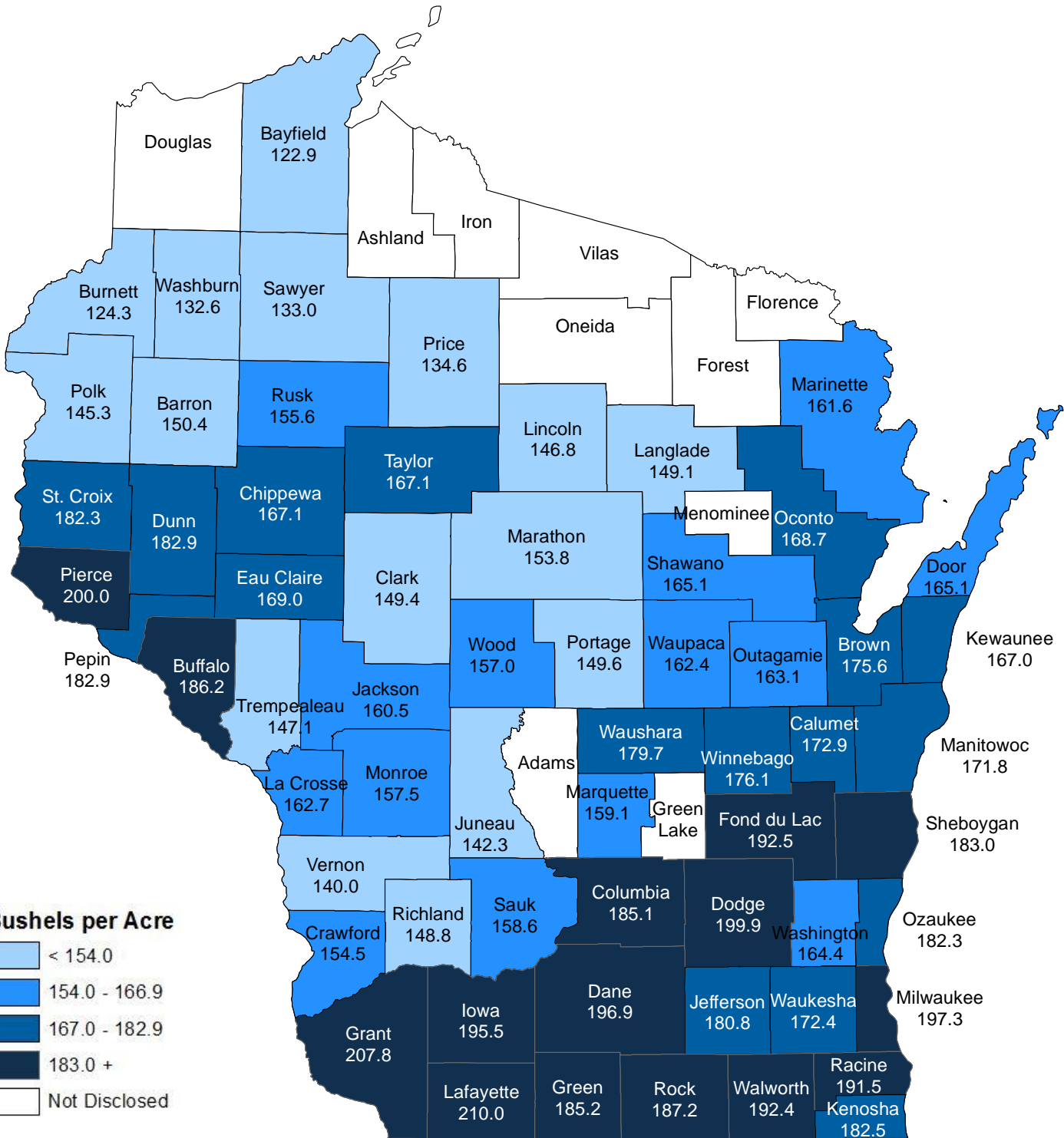

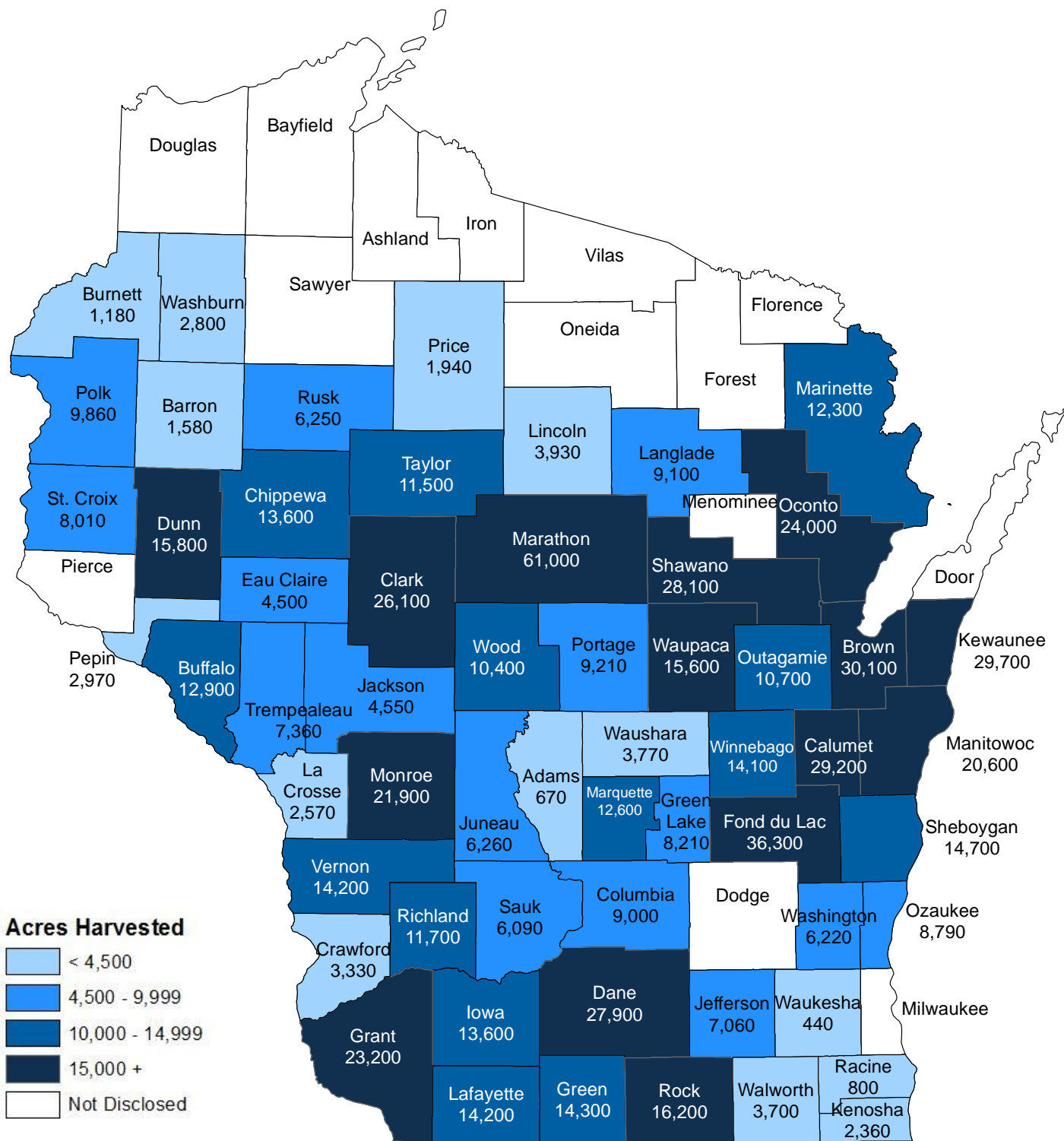

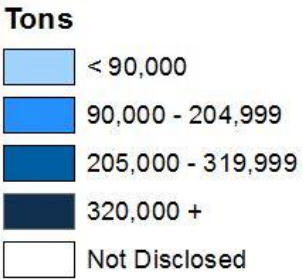

State Total: 16,380,000 Tons



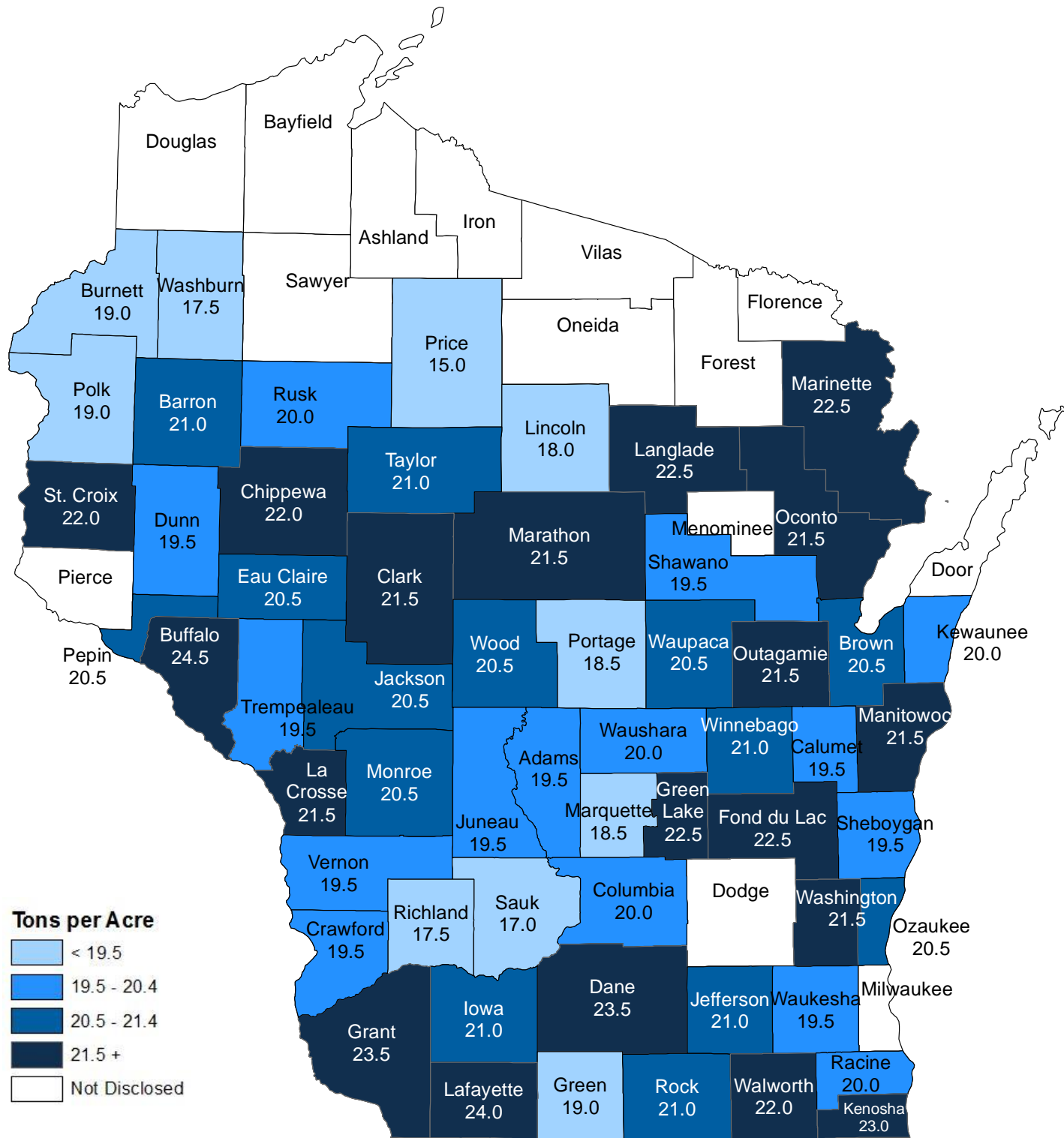
