## **Wisconsin Ag News – Farm Production Expenditures**



Wisconsin farm production expenditures totaled \$11.6 billion in 2021, according to the USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service - Farm Production Expenditures 2021 Summary report. This was \$825 million above the 2020 total expenditures. Feed expense, down 2 percent to \$2.24 billion, represented the largest single production expense in Wisconsin in 2021, accounting for 19 percent of the total. Farm Services, up 7 percent to \$1.58 billion, was the second largest expense and accounted for 14 percent of total expenditures. The largest percentage increases from last year were for Miscellaneous Capital Expenses (up 80 percent), Trucks and Autos (up 39 percent), and Tractors and Self-Propelled Farm Machinery (up 33 percent). The largest percentage decreases from last year were for Interest (down 7 percent), Rent (down 5 percent), and Feed (down 2 percent).

Includes the operator, landlord, and contractor shares of farm production expenses. Totals may not add due to rounding.

Includes purchases and leasing of livestock and poultry. Intra-state and inter-state transfers of livestock are captured.

Includes all crop custom work, veterinary custom services, transportation costs, marketing charges, insurance, leasing of machinery and equipment, utilities, general expenses, and miscellaneous business expenses.

Includes cash rent paid, share rent, plus public and private grazing fees

Includes Indexination dosis. Includes bedding and litter, marketing containers, power farm-shop equipment, oils and lubricants, temporary fencing, miscellaneous non-capital equipment and supplies, repairs and maintenance of equipment not depreciated, and other small, non-capital equipment.

Includes all expenditures related to new construction or repairs of buildings, fences, operator dwelling (if dwelling is owned by operation), and any improvements to physical structures of land.

All purchases of seed, plants, or seed treatments for nursery and farming operation are included. Bedding plants, nursery stock, and seed purchased for resale are excluded.
